

COOKIE POLICY

1. OBJECTIVE

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are and how they may be used within Oterri's portal that offers Oterri services ("**Oterri Services**"). This Cookie Policy supplements the Privacy Policy as available at <https://rdxuat.com/2023-24/oterri/pdf/Privacy-Policy.pdf>. By using the Oterri Services and the portal, User consents that Oterri can use cookies in accordance with this Cookie Policy and the Privacy Policy. All the terms used in capital and not defined in this Cookie Policy shall have the meaning ascribed to it in the Privacy Policy.

2. SCOPE

2.1. **What are Cookies?**

A "Cookie" is a small piece of information stored by a web server on a web browser, so it can be later read back from that browser. Cookies are useful for enabling the browser to remember information specific to a given User. Oterri places both permanent and temporary Cookies in User's computer hard drive. The Cookies do not contain any of User's personally identifiable information.

2.2. Oterri uses Cookies and similar technologies to provide User with essential features of Oterri Services and portal, provide a personalized experience while using the Oterri Services and portal and to improve, protect and promote the portal. Oterri uses data collection services such as "**Cookies**" on the Oterri portal to help analyse the Oterri portal flow, measure promotional effectiveness, and promote trust and safety. Oterri offers certain features that are only available through the use of a "Cookie". Oterri also offers Cookies to allow the User to enter its password less frequently during a session. Cookies can also help Oterri to provide information that is targeted to the User's interests. Most Cookies are "session Cookies", meaning that they are automatically deleted from the User's hard drive at the end of a session.

2.3. These Cookies can be categorized under the following sub-headings:

2.3.1. Strictly Necessary / Essential Cookies: These Cookies are necessary for the portal to function properly. They enable User to navigate the website and use its features. If the User removes or disables these Cookies, the Portal may not be accessible or usable.

2.3.2. Analytical / Performance Cookies: These Cookies analyze and understand how Users use and interact with the portal. The information collected is used to improve the portal's functionality. These Cookies do not contain personal information such as names and email addresses and are used to help Oterri improve user experience of the portal.

2.3.3. Functionality / Preference Cookies: These Cookies allow Oterri to remember choices User makes (such as username, region, etc.) and provide enhanced, more

personalized features. These preferences are remembered (through the use of persistent Cookies) so that User need not set them again the next time they visit the page.

2.3.4. Targeting / Advertising Cookies: These Cookies are used to deliver content that is more relevant to the User and their interests. They may be used to deliver targeted advertising or to limit the number of times a User sees an advertisement.

2.3.5. Third Party Cookies: Cookies may be set by third parties, such as by analytics and advertising companies. These Cookies get re-read during visits to other services if the other services also do business with these companies. When Oterri embed content that is hosted on a third-party's platform on the portal, the third-party may set Cookies on User browser which are usually for the purposes of providing the service as intended (such as for bandwidth management, to store User preference of language, tracking consent and for collecting anonymous statistics such as the number of times a video has been streamed).

2.4. Users are always free to decline Oterri Cookies if the User's browser permits, although in that case the User may not be able to use certain features on the portal and the User may be required to re-enter its password more frequently during a session.

2.5. When Users register themselves on the portal, Oterri creates User's account, assigning a personal identification number, this personal identification number is then sent back to User's hard drive in the form of a Cookie, which is a small bit of code. This code is unique to each User. It enables seamless travel across the portal, allowing User to use the portal without having to enter its password frequently and/or fill out details which User has already provided.

2.6. **How to Control Cookies ?**

User can manage Cookies through their browser's settings. The 'Help' feature on most browsers will tell the User how to remove Cookies from their devices, prevent their browser from accepting new Cookies, how to have the browser notify when User receive a new Cookie, how to disable Cookies, and when Cookies will expire.

2.7. **Changes to This Cookie Policy**

Oterri may update this Cookie Policy from time to time. Oterri will notify the User of any changes by posting the new Cookie Policy on this page. Oterri advises the User to review this Cookie Policy periodically for any changes.
